

UA Scholars Program Overview

The University of Alaska designed the Scholars Program to provide tiam for Alaska's middle and high school students to achieve academic excellence, to nourish efforts of schools to provide high quality education to encourage high school graduates from every community in Alaska to attend the University of Alask

Award amount, distribution and deadline for use

Current award amount: \$11,00@will increase to \$12,000 beginning fall 2015)

How it is paid: The university provides eligible Scholars \$1,375 per semester for eight semesters. (The of tuition for 12 credits in FY1is \$2,08at the 10@200level and \$2,520 the 30@400 level.)

Since the UA Scholar Programman in fall 1999, a cumulative total of 6,713 students have enrolled and received a UA Scholar distribution from the University of Alaska.

Deadline for use: Expires after a total of eight semesters or within five years of the Scholar's class graduation from high school.

Eligible expenses

The A ward is applied as a payment on the Scholar's student account and may be used for expenses such as undergraduate tuition, fees, room, board, books, supplies and other education costs incurred for attendance a University of Alaska.

Eligibility

Top 10 percent in the high school junior class at the end of the spring term (May or June) in every qua Alaska high school.

To remain eligible as aiversity student for the Scholawsand:

- o Maintain satisfactory academizeppess;
- o Enroll in at least2 creditseach all and spring semes (will increase to 0 creditsper academic year in year two of the aware inning fall 2015);
- o Be in good standing accordance with the UA Student Code of Conduct (Board of Regents policy 09.02.02 and UniversRegulation 09.02.020);
- o Maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5.

During its inaugural semester in fall 1999, the UA Scholars program attracted 271 top Alaskan students University of Alaska. Byll 2013, the number newly paid UA Scholars grew456, an increase of 68 percent from the inaugural semester
